Privacy Policy

This privacy policy applies between you, the User of this Website, calls, messages, emails and Dr Anita Aesthetics Clinic, the owner and provider of this Website. Dr Anita Aesthetics Clinic takes the privacy of your information very seriously. This privacy policy applies to our use of any and all Data collected by us or provided by you in relation to your use of the Website.

This privacy policy should be read alongside, and in addition to, our Terms and Conditions, which can be found at www.dranitaesthetics.com website.

Please read this privacy policy carefully.

Definitions and interpretation

In this privacy policy, unless the context requires a different interpretation:

- the singular includes the plural and vice versa;
- references to sub-clauses, clauses, schedules or appendices are to sub-clauses, clauses, schedules or appendices of this privacy policy;
- a reference to a person includes firms, companies, government entities, trusts and partnerships; "including" is understood to mean "including without limitation"; reference to any statutory provision includes any modification or amendment of it;
- the headings and sub-headings do not form part of this privacy policy.

Scope of this privacy policy

This privacy policy applies only to the actions of Dr Anita Aesthetics Clinic and Users with respect to this Website, calls, messages and emails. It does not extend to any websites that can be accessed from this Website including, but not limited to, any links we may provide to social media websites.

For purposes of the applicable Data Protection Laws, Dr Anita Aesthetics Clinic the "data controller". This means that Dr Anita Aesthetics Clinic determines the purposes for which, and the manner in which, your Data is processed.

Data collected

We may collect the following Data, which includes personal Data, from you:

- name;
- date of birth;
- gender;
- demographic information such as postcode,
- preferences,
- treatments,
- medical information,
- photographs;
- IP address (automatically collected);

How we collect Data

We collect Data in the following ways:

- data is given to us by you;
- data is collected automatically also via marketing platforms.

Data that is given to us by you

Dr Anita Aesthetics Clinic will collect your Data in a number of ways, for example:

- when you contact us through the Website, by telephone, post, e-mail or through any other means;
- when you register with us and set up an account to receive our products/services;
- when you make payments to us, through this Website or otherwise;
- when you elect to receive marketing communications from us;
- when you use our services;

Data that is collected automatically

To the extent that you access the Website, we will collect your Data automatically, for example: we automatically collect some information about your visit to the Website. This information helps us to make improvements to Website content and navigation, and includes your IP address, the date, times and frequency with which you access the Website and the way you use and interact with its content.

We will collect your Data automatically via cookies, in line with the cookie settings on your browser.

Our use of Data

Any or all of the above Data may be required by us from time to time in order to provide you with the best possible service and experience when using our Website. Specifically, Data may be used by us for the following reasons:

- internal record keeping;
- improvement of our products / services;
- transmission by email of marketing materials that may be of interest to you;

We may use your Data for the above purposes if we deem it necessary to do so for our legitimate interests. If you are not satisfied with this, you have the right to object

in certain circumstances (see the section headed “Your rights” below).

For the delivery of direct marketing to you via e-mail, we’ll need your consent, whether via an opt-in or soft-opt-in:

Soft opt-in consent is a specific type of consent which applies when you have previously engaged with us (for example, you contact us to ask us for more details about a particular product/service, and we are marketing similar products/services). Under “soft opt-in” consent, we will take your consent as given unless you opt-out.

For other types of e-marketing, we are required to obtain your explicit consent; that is, you need to take positive and affirmative action when consenting by, for example, checking a tick box that we’ll provide.

If you are not satisfied about our approach to marketing, you have the right to withdraw consent at any time. To find out how to withdraw your consent, see the section headed “Your rights” below.

When you register with us and set up an account to receive our services, the legal basis for this processing is the performance of a contract between you and us and/or taking steps, at your request, to enter into such a contract.

Who we share Data with

We may share your Data with the following groups of people for the following reasons:

our employees, agents and/or professional advisors - to obtain advice from professional advisers; in each case, in accordance with this privacy policy.

Keeping Data secure

We will use technical and organisational measures to safeguard your Data, for example:

access to your account is controlled by a password and a user name that is unique to you.

we store your Data on secure servers.

Data retention

Unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by law, we will only hold your Data on our systems for the period necessary to fulfil the purposes outlined in this privacy policy or until you request that the Data be deleted.

Even if we delete your Data, it may persist on backup or archival media for legal, tax or regulatory purposes.

Confidentiality

The Data Protection Act allows access to information that is held about an individual and their personal data. This includes recorded telephone calls.

Requests for copies of telephone conversations can be made under the Data Protection Act as a "Subject Access Request". After assessing whether the information can be released, the requestor can be invited to the practice premise to hear the recording. The right to be forgotten does not override legal and compliance obligations.

If there is a request from an external body relating to the detection or prevention of a crime (e.g. police), then requests for information should be directed to the Manager. Under GDPR, organisations are prohibited from recording the personal conversations of staff, even with consent, and therefore need to ensure that while business calls are recorded, personal calls always remain private.

Your rights

You have the following rights in relation to your Data:

- Right to access- the right to request (i) copies of the information we hold about you at any time, or (ii) that we modify, update or delete such information. If we provide you with access to the information we hold about you, we will not charge you for this, unless your request is "manifestly unfounded or excessive." Where we are legally permitted to do so, we may refuse your request. If we refuse your request, we will tell you the reasons why.
- Right to correct- the right to have your Data rectified if it is inaccurate or incomplete.
- Right to erase- the right to request that we delete or remove your Data from our systems.
- Right to restrict our use of your Data- the right to "block" us from using your Data or limit the way in which we can use it.
- Right to data portability- the right to request that we move, copy or transfer your Data.
- Right to object- the right to object to our use of your Data including where we use it for our legitimate interests.

We may also disclose Data to a prospective purchaser of our business or any part of it.
